Name of the disability	Choose from executive function disorder, auditory processing disorder, dyscalculia, dyslexia, auditory processing disorder and dysgraphia.	
dyslexia	Difficulty with Ietter to sound correspondence. hard to hold the sounds in their memories especially for the length of a paragraph tend to read more slowly because they have to intentionally think of how sounds fit together an't process words automatically.	
dyscalculia	Difficulty recognizing numbers and memorizing math facts	
dysgraphia	Handwriting, capitalization, spelling and getting ideas on paper are difficult.	The control of the co
Executive function disorder	 May not have strategies to organize their work trouble controlling their emotions or focus to work troubles breaking big jobs into achievable tasks often miss deadlines. 	
Auditory processing disorder	They have trouble identifying which sounds to attend to, so long lectures or speeches are hard to decode and understand.	
Visual processing disorder	 May have trouble telling the differences between similar shapes (e.g. b and d). deciding what images to focus on difficulties with videos, graphs, charts, emails or online courses (visual texts) Tendency to skip words or repeat sections when reading, misjudge depth or distance.
