- To start with a sample of 3 masks using our preferred mask pattern and materials that you have at home. Research indicates that materials that are a tight weave, but soft like pillowcase or t-shirt material, are suitable as it needs to be comfortable and breathable.
- Use recommended mask pattern and create 3 masks of 3 different sizes 1 large, 1 medium and 1 small. (Large start with 24 x 17 cm, Medium 23 x 16 cm, Small (child size) 22 x 15 cm).
- Email facemaskproject@sods.sk.ca to submit photos of your sample masks for evaluation.
- Once your samples have been evaluated and ok'd you will receive materials and notions from The Face Mask Project team needed to create more masks.
- Once we receive the completed masks each one will be packaged and sterilized so that they can be safely distributed in the community.
- If you are able commit to another 100 masks.
- A modest payment may be provided at the end of the project.
